I am addressing you in your capacity as the incoming Chairman of the Conference of Community and European Affairs Committees of the Parliaments of the European Union (COSAC).

As you may be aware, Iceland was a candidate country for EU membership until 2015 and participated as such in COSAC meetings. Despite no longer being a candidate country, Iceland nevertheless continues to enjoy a close relationship with the EU through the European Economic Area (EEA) Agreement and various other agreements, and has as such participated in previous COSAC meetings, most recently in Valletta and Tallinn.
